The Chronicler Commands and Interactions

The Chronicler is a Discord Server Bot made for Pen and Paper Role Playing Game (PnPRPG) Servers that records all of the messages it sees into an online database. That database is available to view online at chronicler.seanmfrancis.net where the messages are arranged as a novel. From there, you can download not only your own 'Chronicle', but also any others on the database to read offline and/or later.

To get started, we suggest use the 'Create Channel' command to create a Chronicler channel with pre-set settings. This will add the channel to The Chronicler's database and allow it to start recording the channel. The Chronicler will not record any channel that is not in its database. If you have a channel you wish to add to the database, used the 'Whitelist' command to add the channel into the database.

Note, though, that The Chronicler can only record messages as they are sent, or edit messages that are already in the database. In order to catch special cases, such as recording previous messages or editing messages not in the database, use the 'Rewrite' command to have The Chronicler rewrite the Chronicle as it is when the command is sent.

List of Commands

Command Prefix

Command

!c

Description

The Command Prefix for all commands into The Chronicler. This is how The Chronicler reads a command. If it is not provided, it will determine the message sent as being something to record.

Show Welcome

Command

!c show welcome

Description

Posts the Welcome Menu into this channel. Introduces The Chronicler and gives a quick start for users to immediately start recording.

Can Be Posted In

Any Channel that is Not Blacklisted (see blacklist command).

Show Help

Command

!c show_help

Description

Posts the Help Menu into this channel. Shows all of the commands for The Chronicler and a can show the full description of each by specifying which one to look at.

<u>Examples</u>

```
!c help !c help create channel
```

Can Be Posted In

Any Channel that is Not Blacklisted (see blacklist command).

Rewrite Chronicler

Command

!c rewrite

<u>Description</u>

The Chronicler will run through all of the messages in this channel and recreate the final Chronicle. It will take each message, edit it as normal (remove markdown, symbols, keywords, etc.) and prepare for all of the messages to be posted back into the database.

Can Be Posted In

A channel that has been added to The Chronicler's Database.

Set Privacy

Command

!c set privacy <true or false>

<u>Description</u>

Sets this channel to Private (if true) or Public (if false). Private means that only those with the generated link can view the Chronicle. Public will allow anyone who visits The Chronicler Site to read the Chronicle.

Example

!c set privacy true

Can Be Posted In

A channel that has been added to The Chronicler's Database.

Add Keyword

Command

!c add keyword < Keyword > | < Replacement String >

<u>Description</u>

Adds the specified <Keyword> and its <Replacement String> to the list of Keywords. This will make it so that everytime <Keyword> is in a message, it is replaced by the <Replacement String>. '|' is how The Chronicler knows the separation between <Keyword> and <Replacement String>

Example

!c add keyword dual strike | Baelic swings both of his blades

Can Be Posted In

A channel that has been added to The Chronicler's Database.

Remove Keyword

Command

!c pull keyword <Keyword>

<u>Description</u>

Removes the specified <Keyword> and its associated <Replacement String> from The Chronicler. The <Replacement String> does not need to be included.

Example

!c remove_keyword dual strike

Can Be Posted In

Close Story

Command

!c close_story

<u>Description</u>

Tells The Chronicler to Close this channel's Chronicle, preventing The Chronicler from writing to it until it is reopened. This is not a permanent closure, as you can always open the story back up.

Can Be Posted In

A channel that has been added to The Chronicler's Database.

Open Story

Command

!c open_story

Description

Tells The Chronicler to Open this channel's Chronicle, allowing The Chronicler to write to it until it is closed. If you wish, you can always reclose the Chronicle.

Can Be Posted In

A channel that has been added to The Chronicler's Database.

Set Warnings

Command

!c set warning <List of Warnings>

Description

Sets the List of Warnings for the Chronicle. These warnings will be posted at the top of this channel's Chronicle, helping make sure readers know what may be in the Chronicle. NOTE: This will reset any warnings already set into the Chronicle! If you want to just add onto the list, then use the add warning command below.

Example

!c set warnings Sexual Content, Drug and Alcohol Reference, Violence

Can Be Posted In

A channel that has been added to The Chronicler's Database.

Add Warning

Command

!c add_warning <Warning>

Description

Adds the <Warning> to the list of Warnings.

Example

!c add_warning Heavy Language

Can Be Posted In

A channel that has been added to The Chronicler's Database.

Remove Warning

Command

!c pull warning <Warning>

Description

Removes <Warning> from the list of Warnings, if it exists in the list.

Example

!c pull_warning Sexual Content

Can Be Posted In

A channel that has been added to The Chronicler's Database.

Clear Warning

Command

!c clear_warning

<u>Description</u>

Clears all warnings from the channel in the database, if any.

Can Be Posted In

A channel that has been added to The Chronicler's Database.

Ignore Message

Command

!c ignore

<u>Description</u>

Tells The Chronicler to Ignore this message. Can be used to send a message that should not be recorded by The Chronicler.

Can Be Posted In

Any Channel that is Not Blacklisted (see blacklist command).

Ignore Users

Command

!c ignore_user <User Name>

<u>Description</u>

Adds the specified <User Name> to the list of users The Chronicler will ignore. Any messages by the user will not be recorded by The Chronicler. This can also be used to ignore multiple users at once using the '|' separator.

Examples

```
!c ignore_user Miggnor
!c ignore_user Miggnor | Calli | Billi_Bob
```

Can Be Posted In

A channel that has been added to The Chronicler's Database.

Remove Ignored Users

Command

```
!c pull_ignored_user <User Name>
```

<u>Description</u>

Removes the specified <User Name> from the list of ignored users. This can also be used to remove multiple ignored users at once using the '|' separator.

Examples

```
!c pull_ignored_user Miggnor
!c pull_ignored_user Miggnor | Calli | Billi_Bob
```

Can Be Posted In

A channel that has been added to The Chronicler's Database.

Get Story Link

Command

!c get link

<u>Description</u>

This will tell The Chronicler to post a direct link to your Chronicle.

Can Be Posted In

Get General Stats

Command

!c stats general

Description

This will tell The Chronicler to post your channel's general statistics.

Can Be Posted In

A channel that has been added to The Chronicler's Database.

Get Keyword Stats

Command

!c stats_keywords

Description

This will tell The Chronicler to post your channel's keywords.

Can Be Posted In

A channel that has been added to The Chronicler's Database.

Get Symbol Stats

Command

!c stats_symbols

<u>Description</u>

This will tell The Chronicler to post your channel's start and end symbols.

Can Be Posted In

Get All Stats

Command

!c stats all

<u>Description</u>

This will tell The Chronicler to post all of your channel's statistics.

Can Be Posted In

A channel that has been added to The Chronicler's Database.

Blacklist Channel

Command

!c blacklist channel

<u>Description</u>

This will tell The Chronicler to completely lock this channel and its Chronicle from its database after a single warning. BE CAREFUL: The moment you Confirm it, The Chronicler will irreversibly prevent you from seeing any data of the Chronicle, read any record of the Chronicle from the site and nothing else in the blacklisted channel will be recorded ever again!

Can Be Posted In

Any Channel that is Not Blacklisted (see blacklist command).

Create Channel

Command

!c create channel <Options>

<u>Description</u>

Creates a new channel in the server set up for The Chronicler. < Options > are optional by replacing < Options > with the desired options (if not provided, it is set up with the default

values). <Options> must be formatted as follows (without quotes), separated by a semicolon (;):

- channel_name=<New Channel Name> (What the new channel will be named) (Default:<Your UserName>s Chronicle)
- is_private=true or is_private=false (Is the Chronicle Private?) (Default: is private=false)
- keyword=<Keyword> | <ReplacementString> (Set up Keywords and Replacement Strings) (Can Be Used Multiple Times) (Default: None)
- warnings=<Warnings> (Create List of Warnings) (Default: None)
- ignore_users=<User Name> | <User Name>... (Set up List of Ignored Users) (Default: None)
- sole_ownership=true or sole_ownership=false (If true, the user who entered the command will be the only one to have permissions for the new channel) (Default: sole ownership=true)
- rewrite=true or rewrite=false (If true, will immediately start to rewrite the Chronicle. If False, it will not start rewriting. NOTE: Depending on how many messages are in the channel, this may take a while. Do not post any messages until it is complete.) (Default: rewrite=false)
- show_welcome=true or show_welcome=false (Shows the welcome message once the channel is created) (Default: show welcome=true)
- show_help=true or show_help=false (Shows the help message once the channel is created) (Default: show help=true)
- is_nsfw=true or is_nsfw=false (Is the Channel Not Safe For Work) (Default: is nsfw=false)

<u>Example</u>

!c create_channel is_private=false; keyword=-dual strike | Baelic swings both of his blades; keyword=-magic_missle | Gilla casts magic missile; warnings=Sexual Content, Drug and Alcohol Reference, Violence; ignore_users=Miggnor | Calli | Billi_Bob; sole_ownership=true

Can Be Posted In

Any Channel that is Not Blacklisted (see blacklist command).

Whitelist Channel

Command

!c whitelist <Options>

Description

Adds the channel into The Chroniclers database. < Options > are optional (if not provided, it is set up for the default values). < Options > must be formatted as follows (without the quotes), separated by a semicolon (;):

- is_private=true or is_private=false (Is the Chronicle Private?) (Default: is private=false)
- keyword=<Keyword> | <ReplacementString> (Set up Keywords and Replacement Strings) (Can Be Used Multiple Times) (Default: None)
- warnings=<Warnings> (Create List of Warnings) (Default: None)
- ignore_users=<User Name> | <User Name>... (Set up List of Ignored Users) (Default: None)
- sole_ownership=true or sole_ownership=false (If true, the user who entered the command will be the only one to have permissions for the new channel) (Default: sole_ownership=true)
- rewrite=true or rewrite=false (If true, will immediately start to rewrite the Chronicle. If False, it will not start rewriting. NOTE: Depending on how many messages are in the channel, this may take a while. Do not post any messages until it is complete.) (Default: rewrite=false)
- show_welcome=true or show_welcome=false (Shows the welcome message once the channel is created) (Default: show welcome=true)
- show_help=true or show_help=false (Shows the help message once the channel is created) (Default: show_help=true)
- is_nsfw=true or is_nsfw=false (Is the Channel Not Safe For Work) (Default: is_nsfw=false)

<u>Example</u>

!c whitelist is_private=false; keyword=-dual strike | Baelic swings both of his blades; keyword=-magic_missle | Gilla casts magic missile; warnings=Sexual Content, Drug and Alcohol Reference, Violence; ignore_users=Miggnor | Calli | Billi_Bob; sole_ownership=true

Can Be Posted In

Any Channel that is Not Blacklisted (see blacklist command).

Rename Channel

Command

!c rename channel <New Name>

Description

Renames the channel in the database to the <New Name>. NOTE: This will only rename the channel in The Chronicler Database. You will need to manually change the name in Discord if you wish to have the names consistent.

Example

!c rename_channel Let's Do This

Can Be Posted In

A channel that has been added to The Chronicler's Database.

Roll Dice

Command

!c roll <Special Text> <Dice Code>

<u>Description</u>

This will tell The Chronicler to roll dice based on the Dice Code.

The special text is any text that you want that will help you remember what the roll was for.

The Dice Code must be in this format: (Any Number)d(Any Number)(+/-)(Any Number). The Chronicler also supports Fate Dice with either of these codes: (Any Number)dF, (Any Number)df.

Options

- (Any Number)d(Any Number)
- (Any Number)d(Any Number)+(Any Number)
- (Any Number)d(Any Number)-(Any Number)
- (Any Number)dF
- (Any Number)dF+(Any Number)
- (Any Number)dF-(Any Number)
- (Any Number)df
- (Any Number)df+(Any Number)
- (Any Number)df-(Any Number)

Examples

- !c roll 1d6
- !c roll 4dF
- !c roll 10d100
- !c roll 4dF+2
- !c Defense Against Guard 1d20+3

Can Post In

Any Channel

Special Interactions

Roll Dice In Message

<u>Input</u>

[roll="<Special Text>"]<Die Code>[/roll]

<u>Description</u>

This will tell The Chronicler to roll dice based on the Dice Code.

The special text is any text that you want that will help you remember what the roll was for. The Dice Code must be in this format: (Any Number)d(Any Number)(+/-)(Any Number). The Chronicler also supports Fate Dice with either of these codes: (Any Number)dF, (Any Number)df. You can spell 'roll' in these ways: roll, Roll, and ROLL. You can use single or double quotes. This can be used multiple times in a single message.

This is different from the roll command (!c roll) as you are able to put this into a message with other text and it will still work. Not only that, but doing it this way will put the roll into the database.

Options

- [roll="<Special Text>"]<Die Code>[/roll]
- [ROLL='<Special Text>']<Die Code>[/ROLL]
- [Roll='<Special Text>']<Die Code>[/roll]

Examples

• The whole world saw it when Tallys [roll="leapt for the railing"]4df+3[/roll] hoping to grab on before the airship flew away. As she did, the sniper on the

- crows nest took careful aim before [roll="firing the rifle"]4df+2[/roll] in his hands.
- He was not going to let this creature get away. With a moment to get under control, he [Roll="charged forward."]1d20+10[/roll]

Can Use In
